Player Covid-19 Protocols

Members must ensure they stay within the guidance to protect the good name of our club.

Please find below the specific plans and guidance we have in place at the current time

- You do not attend if you are displaying any symptoms or are required to isolate. Please contact your captain ASAP so they can find a replacement player.
- You turn up ready to play as changing rooms will be shut before, during and after the game.
- You do not share equipment.
- You do not apply sweat or saliva to the ball
- You bring any food and drink you wish to consume during the game as no teas are provided.
- You always remain socially distanced, including during the game
- You comply with track and trace protocols
- You have your own supply of hand sanitiser if possible

GROUND PROTOCOLS

1. Home and away players have designated parking and seating/player areas on the ground as directed by the home captain or club representative. 2m social distancing to be respected at all times

2. Entry to the pavilion will be allowed on a strict one in one out basis for the use of a single toilet facility only

3. Hand sanitisers will be available and are to be used upon entry into the pavilion, and upon exit if necessary.

4. Anyone using the toilet must use the hand sanitiser or cold water and soap to wash their hands after use NB It is an enclosed cubicle . Face masks should be worn
5. Paper towels will be available for drying hands and must be disposed of as per item 6.
6. Anyone using the toilet should follow the written instructions inside to wipe over with the provided sanitiser wipes all touch points including door handles when opening and closing, wc handle, wc seat ,water tap . Light switch / fan to be left ON . Used wipes to be disposed of in dedicated waste bin immediately outside toilet door
7. The club doors will be shut when home side are in the field and no access permitted to the clubhouse except during any comfort breaks agreed by the captains beforehand
8. No kitchen , water , food , changing or shower facilities will be available
9. No portable outside or inside seating will be available other than players' own except for emergency use
10. Ball search parties from either side must pre sanitise their hands, and/or the metal poles with the spray provided , before using them to search in the undergrowth . Ball search parties to stay 2 m apart at all times and use hand sanitiser on completion of search
11. During rain breaks players will be expected to return to their cars. 2m distancing should be maintained on the veranda at all times.
12. Spectators – We welcome any friends or family as spectators, however, please remind them to socially distance and not to touch the ball at any time. They must not attend if they display any symptoms. Please remind them to bring their own supplies of sanitiser
13. Conduct – All spectators must respect the above points and comply with our track and trace procedure. If anybody does not comply with our guidance, they may be asked to leave the club on the day.
